This letter is in response to your letter of October 3, 1997. According to your letter, there are two items to be completed: (a) completion of the refunds and (b) payment of interest to the city. While we agree that you must complete payment of the refunds, we must advise that the payment of the interest must also go to the customers. As you may be aware, in order to accomplish this, representatives from the Turkey Creek Master Owners Association are working with the Office of Public Counsel in arranging a settlement for the interest.

In addition, on several occasions you and I have discussed the payment of the \$1,314.74, representing the Miscellaneous Service Charges, the Late Fee and the Interest on Customer Deposits (as of June 13, 1996) to the City of Alachua. Before we can bring this matter to the Commission's attention, we must have a better understanding as to why it is difficult to determine who is eligible for these refunds. Therefore, please file a statement indicating why you are unable to determine who is eligible for the refunds and why it should be paid to the City.
