

C. Technical Capability

The primary purpose of this application is to facilitate deployment of data transfer services via existing telecommunication copper circuits. Our staff is capable to deal with all aspects of any data transfer issues, which may arise. Performance has been demonstrated over the past 14 months as an Internet Service Provider.

Our data center is located in the downtown area of Tallahassee. Our main server utilizes dual Pentium processors, 128meg of RAM and 4gig of fast wide SCSI storage. The main server is scheduled for upgrade by November 1, 1997 with a dual Pentium Sun Spark 20 also equipped with 128meg of RAM and 4gig of storage. ElectroNet supports both UNIX and Windows NT web servers with back-up power in the event of electrical failure.

ElectroNet offers one of the most direct T-1 connections to the Atlanta Internet backbone in the North Florida marketplace. Our network connection has only one hop to the Internet via a 45Mbps. T-3 ATM interface. Both the T-3 and T-1 are less than 50 percent subscribed providing robust performance to and from the Internet. ElectroNet is the only local Internet Service Provider (ISP) with this high level of connectivity.

ElectroNet uses all digital modems for File Transfer Protocol (FTP) and dial access. ElectroNet's dial equipment supports both USR's X-2 and Rockwell/Lucent's K56Flex chipsets with modem speeds from 14.4 to 56k. Currently ElectroNet maintains a 6 user to modem ratio, which has proven sufficient to avoid busy signals.

Technical issues related to any telecommunication issues are dealt with by our membership in the Partners Program with Paradyne Corporation of Largo FL. Paradyne is the manufacturer of the data equipment which we are using to provide data services to our clients. Paradyne offers us access to its telecommunication engineers as necessary. Should the need present itself we will add to staff someone with the necessary skills to satisfy those needs.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
JULY 31, 1997

(1) Summary of Significant Accounting Policies:

The following is a summary of the more significant accounting policies and practices of Electro Net Intermedia Consulting Inc. (the "Company") which affect the accompanying financial statements.

(a) **The Company**—Electro Net Intermedia Consulting Inc. is an internet access provider located in the State of Florida and was founded in August 1996. The Company specializes in web site design and network consultation.

(b) **Property and Equipment**—Property and equipment is recorded at cost. Depreciation is computed using the straight-line method over the estimated useful lives of the assets which are five years.

(c) **Cash and Cash Equivalents**—For purposes of reporting cash flows, cash and cash equivalents include cash on hand, amounts due from banks and certificates of deposit with original maturities of less than ninety days.

(d) **Income Taxes**—The Company has elected to be taxed under the provisions of Subchapter S of the Internal Revenue Code. Under those provisions, the Company does not pay Federal corporate income taxes on its taxable income. Instead, the stockholder is liable for individual Federal income taxes on the Company's taxable income.

(e) **Use of Estimates**—The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from the used estimates.

(f) **Amortization**—Start-up costs are being amortized on the straight-line method over 60 months.

(2) Concentrations of Credit Risk:

(a) **Demand and Time Deposits**—The Company has demand and time deposits with a local bank. The balance as of July 31, 1997, is as follows:
