

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 367.045, Florida Statutes, and the provisions of Florida Public Service Commission Rule 35.30.030 Notice is hereby given by Spruce Creek South Utilities, Inc., 17503 Southeast 102nd Avenue, Summerfield, Florida 34491 of its Application to extend its service area to provide water and sewer service to the following described lands in Sumter County, Florida:

Commence at the SW corner of the N.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 1 Township 18 South, Range 23 East, Thence N.88°27'07"E along the South line of the N.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said section, a distance of 179.23 feet to a point on the Southeast right of way line of U.S. Highway 27 441 being a 200 foot right of way; and the Point of Beginning Thence S. 41°46'50"E along said right of way line, a distance of 370.00 feet to a point on the Northern right of way line of County Road 109, thence S. 48°13'10"W, along said right of way line, a distance of 100.41 feet to the Point of curvature of a 350.00 foot radius curve, concave to the Southeast, thence along the arc of said curve, through a central angle of 35°00'00", a distance of 213.80 feet to the point of tangency, thence continue along said right of way line, S.13°13'10"W, a distance of 120.66 feet, thence departing said right of way line, N41°46'50"W, a distance of 1665.10 feet, thence S.09°51'32"E, a distance of 337.59 feet to a point on the Southeast right of way line of said U.S. Highway 27 441; thence S.41°46'50"E along said right of way line, a distance of 803.42 feet to the Point of Beginning.
