On behalf of our client, Plantation Utilities, this letter is a response to the Certificate Transfer Audit dated September 12, 1997. This response does not include comments on those audit exceptions or disclosures with which the Company either agrees or believes that no response is necessary.

### Audit Exception No. 1

In this exception, \$1,642 of Water Utilit; Plant was misclassified to Water - Land. Thus, Land was overstated and Utility Plant understated, with no effect on rate base.

The Utility will make the appropriate adjustment on its books.

#### Audit Exception No. 2

This exception deals with \$711 in capitalized repairs for the water plant, ostensibly for legal expense, equipment repairs, and engineering.

The Company believes this is an immaterial adjustment and although the auditor was requested to provide the Company with information to support this exception, none was made available to Plantation.

This adjustment should be rejected on materiality alone.

### Audit Exception No. 3

This exception recommends that \$80 of water plant and \$9 of wastewater plant be disallowed for discounts not taken.

This exception should be rejected on materiality alone. For the record, we note that no materiality standards were established for this audit. The amounts are so minor that they could not conceivably have an impact on the cost of service.

#### Audit Exception No. 4

This exception notes that the Utility did not record the retirement of \$5,813 and \$3,457 of water and wastewater plant, respectively, at December 31, 1996.

Plantation Utilities agrees that these retirement entries should be made. Failure to record the retirement by the Company's part-time bookkeeper was simply an oversight and does not rise to the level of a willful violation, as implied in the language of Audit Exception No. 4.

#### Audit Exception No. 5

This exception deals with plant additions of \$8,548 and \$928 for water and sewer, respectively, related to a pump used for irrigation of a golf course. The auditor recommends that this is non-utility property and should be removed from the Company's plant accounts.

The Utility disagrees. These expenditures were related to a pump used for delivery of reuse water from the wastewater treatment plant to the storage facilities at the golf course. Thus, the expenditures are Utility property and should not be eliminated. The \$8,548 water addition should be reclassified as sewer plant.

#### Audit Exception No. 6

In this exception, the auditor believes that capital additions of \$56,883 and \$6,927 for water and wastewater plant, respectively, were not supported by credible documentation.

This exception includes a schedule which details various plant items which, allegedly, were unsupported. Plantation disagrees, in part, and the specific items from the auditor's schedule with which the Company disagrees are set forth below.

 The first adjustment to water plant relates to an "unclassified" plant addition at Ms. Blanca S. Bayo October 30, 1997 Page 3

December 31, 1996. The Company had no such unclassified utility plant on its general ledger or the Annual Report and does not believe such an item exists. Plantation has been unsuccessful in obtaining additional information about this item from the auditor.

- 2. An April, 1986, addition for \$5,053 was disallowed. The "tility has researched this item further and found a supporting invoice for this amount from Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc., the engineers who designed the water and wastewater treatment plant expansions in 1986. Certain common construction costs, such as engineering, the utility operations building, and other common costs, were allocated 50 percent to water and 50 percent to sewer. This methodology was accepted in Plantation's last rate case. The invoice is attached.
- 3. December, 1987, additions to the water plant amounting to \$2,869 were disallowed. These additions related to several invoices from George Dietz Electric Company for construction of the water plant and utility operations building. Plantation has found partial support for these additions totalling \$399.50. The invoice is attached.
- 4. The July, 1987, water plant addition attributed to Rio Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$7,000 was eliminated as a double recorded amount. This is not correct. Further investigation revealed that this addition was from W. N. Maddox Construction, Inc. and represented 50 percent of a progress billing for construction of the water and sewer utility operations building. A copy of the invoice is attached.
- 5. An August, 1987, water addition of \$4,800 was eliminated for no support. This amount represented 50 percent of the final payment to W. N. Maddox Construction, Inc. for construction of the water and sewer operations building. A copy of the invoice and a schedule showing the final payment and allocation between water and sewer is attached. These costs were reviewed in the Company's last sewer rate case and 50 percent

of the total contract was included in plant in service approved by the Commission.

#### Audit Exception No. 8

In this exception, the auditor recommends that a capitalized wastewater repair of \$1,756 should be disallowed on the basis that it is non-recurring.

The amount capitalized was for rewinding of a motor which the Utility believes is a betterment which extends the useful life of the asset. As a result, the Company's treatment to capitalize the rewinding of this motor was correct. The Company also takes exception to the auditor's finding that the rewinding of motors is a non-recurring event. These things happen all the time and are a normal part of utility operations.

#### Audit Disclosure No. 1

In this disclosure, the auditor expresses his concern with debit balances of certain plant accumulated depreciation accounts as a result of retirements. The debit balances range from \$571 to \$6,197.

Plantation Utilities believes these are immaterial debit balances which should correct themselves in a few years and no additional retirement treatment should be considered. Additionally, the Company would point out that accumulated depreciation and expense are considered in their entirety in the determination of cost of service.






