RE: DOCKET NO. 970546-EG - Petition by Florida Power & Light Company for modification of Off-Peak Battery Charging Program.

Issue 1: Should the Commission approve Florida Power & Light Company's (FPL) petition for modification of the Commercial/Industrial (C/I) Off-Peak Battery Charging program, including approval for energy conservation cost recovery (ECCR)?

Recommendation: Yes. The C/I Off-Peak Battery Charging program, as modified, is cost-effective. Increasing the program's incentive is expected to encourage program participation. This will assist FPL in meeting its Commission-approved Demand-Side Management (DSM) goals. Reasonable and prudent expenditures for the program, as modified, should be approved for cost recovery, and the resulting demand savings should continue to count toward FPL's DSM goals.
