MOTION TO EXTEND TIME FOR SURVEY BY AN ADDITIONAL 45 DAYS


The Citizens of Florida ("Citizens"), by and through Jack Shreve, Public Counsel, move the Florida Public Service Commission to allow an additional 45 days to conduct a survey of Haines City's subscribers for extended area service. In support of this motion, the Citizens submit the following:

1. Order No. PSC-97-1308-FOF-TL issued October 22, 1997, requires GTE Florida, Inc. to survey Haines City customers for a 25/25 extended area service plan with regrouping within 45 days of the issuance of the order.
2. This deadline would require the survey to be conducted during a holiday period, and this may lead to subscribers inadvertently overlooking the survey. If the deadline for the survey were extended an additional 45 days, the survey could be conducted in January, 1998, after the holiday season.

3. The Citizens recognize that the time for filing a motion for reconsideration of order no. PSC-97-1308-FOF-TL has passed. Nevertheless, in the interest of ensuring an accurate and valid survey of the customers in Haines City, we request the Commission to extend the time for the survey so that it will be conducted within 90 days from the date of issuance of order no. PSC-97-1308-FOF-TL, rather than 45 days.
