





Parcels A & B are presently zoned commercial and will require water and sewer service as well as fire flows in order to be developed. Marion Utilities could provide only water service for this area at this time. Decca Utilities has applied to service this area under Docket No. 971157-WS FPSC and has the capability to provide the full services. As Marion Utilities is not providing service to this area at present, it will not affect any customers.

Parcel C is a piece of property being purchased by Decca Utilities and will become part of the Oak Run Development. As Decca Utilities is serving all of Oak Run, it is logical that they be allowed to serve this area also. Marion Utilities does not have any customers in this area.




