**GTE FLORIDA INCORPORATED'S NOTICE OF  
INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

In accordance with Florida Statutes, Section 384.183 and Commission Rule 25-22.006, GTE Florida Incorporated (GTEFL) files this notice of intent to request confidential classification for documents to be provided to the Office of the Attorney General (AG). Specifically, GTEFL is providing this confidential information to the AG in response to the AG's November 24, 1997 letter to GTEFL (attached), in which the AG asked to review documents that GTEFL has already produced to the Office of Public Counsel (OPC) in response to OPC's first set of requests for production of documents. GTEFL filed a Motion for Temporary Protective Order with regard to the production to OPC on October 17, 1997. The instant Notice covers these same documents.

If and when the AG notifies the Company which confidential documents the AG will use at the hearing in this case, GTEFL will file a detailed motion for permanent confidential classification. In the meantime, GTEFL understands that this Notice protects the claimed confidential information from public disclosure and exempts it from the provisions of Florida Statutes, Section 119.07(1).

The documents designated as confidential contain statistics regarding the number and percentage of slamming complaints by specific carriers and the names and telephone numbers

of customers who complained that their carrier was changed without their consent. The documents in question have been Bates-stamped numbers 16-33; 59-62; 181-198; and 199-204. This material is treated by GTEFL as confidential and has not been publicly disclosed. Public disclosure of these data could compromise the privacy of the subscribers whose names and telephone numbers appear in the documents at issue, and could harm the competitive interests of GTEFL and the other carriers involved.
