| 6 | SWORN EXAMINATION |
| 7 | BY MR. BISHOP: |
| 8 | Q Would you please state your name? |
| 9 | A Jack R. Brown. |
| 10 | Q And, Mr. Brown, what is your business |
| 11 | address? |
| 12 | A It's 108 North Jefferson Street, Perry, |
| 13 | Florida. |
| 14 | Q And what is your profession, sir? |
| 15 | A I'm the County Coordinator for the Board of |
| 16 | County of Commissioners, Taylor County, Florida. |
| 17 | Q Would you give us a brief background of your |
| 18 | educational background and work experience, sir. |
| 19 | A Sure. I graduated from the University of |
| 20 | Florida in 1978 with a Bachelors Degree in Business, |
| 21 | and I obtained a Masters in Business Administration |
| 22 | from the Florida Institute of Technology in 1989. I |
| 23 | also have a Masters Degree in Strategic Planning |
| 24 | achieved from the Navy War College in '93. And in '94 |
| 25 | I achieved another Masters Degree in Operational and |

- Strategic Planning through the Command and General
- 2 Staff while I was in the Army.
- 3 Q And you have been in the service before?
- 4 A Yes. I was a Strategic Planner for the
- 5 United States Army. I was one of the lead planners for
- our operation with NATO in Bosnia. I was hired as the
- 7 County Coordinator upon my retiring from the Army, and
- 8 I've been with the county now for a year.
- 9 Q What briefly is your job as County
- 10 Coordinator for the Board of County Commissioners of
- 11 Taylor County, sir?
- 12 A Well, I'm responsible for the day-to-day
- operations of the County. The interface of the County
- 14 Staff with the Board of County Commissioners and the
- 15 public at large.
- 16 O Does your job as County Coordinator encompass
- you being in contact with the citizens of Taylor
- 18 County?
- 19 A Yes, it does. On a daily basis, I'm in
- 20 contact by telephone, and also face-to-face
- 21 coordination with various civic groups and individual
- citizens that might have issues that they want to
- 23 address.
- Q Is Taylor County a rather large county with
- regard to area? In other words, land area?

Well, we have a small population, 1 roughly twenty-one thousand. We are one of the largest 2 land mass counties in the state. 3 Have you ever testified before this Commission? 5 Α No, I have not. 6 And what is the purpose of your testimony 0 7 here this afternoon? 8 The purpose of my testimony is to address the 9 Α issues identified in Docket No. 930235-TL. 10 Those issues include whether a sufficient 11 community of interest exist between the pocket of 12 customers served by the BellSouth Exchange of Cross 13 City located in Taylor County, and the GTC Incorporated 14 Exchange located in Taylor County, to justify the need 15 for local service throughout the county. 16 Have you or anyone from your office done any 17 surveys with respect to what those needs are? 18 We have not been able to conduct a scientific 19 survey, due to the small staff that we have. However, 20 in the last several years, this subject has been 21 approached in no less than fourteen County Commissioner 22 meetings. 23 I have received during my tenure here in the 24

past year numerous calls complaining that citizens have

25

- 1 to pay long distance charges every time they try to
- 2 coordinate any type of county business, or when they
- 3 call the high school, or conducting any business with
- 4 any of the elected officials.
- 5 Q Is Steinhatchee an incorporated area, or are
- 6 they unincorporated?
- 7 A Steinhatchee is an unincorporated community.
- 8 Q And how far in distance is it from the County
- 9 Seat of Perry, Taylor County?
- 10 A Steinhatchee is approximately forty miles
- away from the community of Perry, which is the County
- 12 Seat.
- 13 It's the second largest municipality,
- unincorporated. It's the largest unincorporated
- municipality in the county. There's only one
- incorporated municipality, and that's Perry.
- 17 But this problem tends to polarize
- 18 Steinhatchee with the county government, because they
- 19 feel like everything that they try to coordinate with,
- 20 they have to expend extra funds, such as long distance
- 21 phone calls, driving, et cetera, to effect coordination
- 22 with the County Seat.
- 23 Q On the other hand, does it also affect our
- 24 citizens who live, say, in Perry in doing business with
- 25 the folks in Steinhatchee?

- 1 A Yes, it does. One of the other problems is
- 2 that local contractors who want to do business in
- 3 Steinhatchee have to pay long distance rates for an
- 4 area that is in the county.
- 5 Q And then is also the same true with family
- 6 members just visiting over the telephone?
- 7 A Yes. It makes every facet of coordination of
- 8 day-to-day life in the county more costly to the
- 9 average citizen.
- 10 Q In Perry, in Taylor County, there's also
- 11 unincorporated areas that are north of Perry, are there
- 12 not?
- 13 A Yes, there are.
- Q And those areas are like Shady Grove --
- 15 A Eridu.
- 16 Q -- Eridu?
- 17 A Right.
- 18 Q And those areas are a good distance, are they
- 19 not, from Perry?
- 20 A Yes, they are.
- 21 Q Shady Grove being at least twelve miles?
- 22 A Thirteen miles.
- Q And then Eridu is even farther, is it not?
- 24 A Right. We have other areas that are to the
- west that are even farther that are, if you look at

- 1 Nut-All Rise and Econfina, it is almost as far as it is
- 2 to Steinhatchee, yet they have local phone service.
- 3 Q In other words, we can make a local phone
- 4 call from Perry to Nut-All Rise and to Lake Bird and to
- 5 Shady Grove?
- 6 A Shady Grove and Eridu, but not to
- 7 Steinhatchee.
- 8 Q So the Steinhatchee area is the only area in
- 9 the county that's not covered by local phone service?
- 10 A Correct.
- 11 O And this has been for a considerable period
- of time, has it not?
- 13 A Yes, it has.
- 14 Q In your opinion, based upon your testimony
- that you've given today, could you just reiterate for
- the Commission what benefit you find, as the County
- 17 Coordinator, and also for your bosses, the Board of
- 18 County Commissioners, what benefit it would be to have
- 19 the local service to Steinhatchee?
- 20 A For one, it would be a lot less costly for
- 21 the local government to conduct day-to-day business and
- 22 effect coordination, and the same is true for the
- 23 average citizen.
- 24 It would help, I think, also to bring the
- community closer together. And, you know, it's seems

- to me that it is only fair that the citizens in
- 2 Steinhatchee are provided local phone service to their
- 3 County Seat.
- It's in Perry where you have all the schools
- 5 and all the facilities.
- 6 Q Hospitals.
- 7 A Hospitals. The vast majority of contractors
- 8 all come out of Perry.
- 9 (AN OFF-THE-RECORD DISCUSSION WAS HAD.)
- 10 BY MR. BISHOP:
- 11 Q Mr. Brown, are there other areas that local
- service would help with regard to, say, fire protection
- or police protection of our county, or the citizens of
- 14 our county?
- 15 A Yes. The critical functions that the
- 16 government provide, such as fire protection and law
- 17 enforcement, would be enhanced by this.
- 18 Right now for 911 service, our 911 calls are
- 19 routed through Dixie County, and then back to Taylor
- 20 County. The Sheriff's Department has an 800 number,
- but it's very costly for them to maintain that 800
- 22 number.
- 23 O Is that about it?
- 24 A That pretty much sums it up.
- MR. BISHOP: Thank you, sir.

| 3 | Q Just another question. |
| 4 | What effect would having this local service |
| 5 | have, all the way down to Steinhatchee, and with all of |
| 6 | the coast lines of Taylor County, versus not having it |
| 7 | within these areas along the coastline? |
| 8 | A Well, Taylor County is considered by FEMA |
| 9 | (Phonetically) one of the most dangerous coastlines in |
| 10 | the United States for storms. |
| 11 | Currently being divided by two area codes |
| 12 | complicates our ability to be able to respond to all of |
| 13 | the residents of the community in case of a natural |
| 14 | disaster such as the terrible storm that we went |
| 15 | through in 1993 that cost many lives in the community. |
| 16 | Now, this would help streamline our ability |
| 17 | to respond in a timely and efficient manner to protect |
| 18 | lives and property in such a disaster. |
| 19 | Q Okay. Now that finally concludes it, right? |
| 20 | A Right. I just wanted to double check my |
| 21 | notes. |
