Charlotte County, (the County) 18500 Murdock Circle, Port Charlotte, Florida 33948-1094, by and through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to Rule 25-22.041, Florida Administrative Code respectfully files this Amended Motion for Continuance or Request for Deferral related to the appropriateness of a surcharge/refund as addressed in Order No. PSC-97-1033-PCO-WS and Order No. PSC-97-1290-PCO-WS, now scheduled for a Commission Special Agenda Conference on December 15, 1997. As grounds therefor the County states:

In the original Motion for Continuance or Request for Deferral filed on November 26, 1997, paragraphs 4 and 5 made reference to the case entitled "St. Jude Catholic Church vs. Florida Public Service Commission, Case No. 97-5407-CA-C". That matter is not pending before the First District Court of Appeals, but is currently the subject of a proceeding before the Circuit Court of the Fifth Judicial Circuit in and for Marion County, Florida. The reference to the First District Court of Appeals appearing in paragraphs 4 and 5 should be revised accordingly.

WHEREFORE, and in consideration of the foregoing, Charlotte County requests that the Commission allow for the amended Motion for Continuance or Request for Deferral as stated above.




