**AMENDMENT TO NOTICE OF FILING**

On August 18, 1997, City Gas Company of Florida, an operating division of NUI Corporation, ("NUI/City Gas" or "the Company"), filed its Notice of Filing Cost-Effectiveness Evaluation of Energy Conservation Programs and Request for Program Approval. After discussions with the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission and careful consideration of staff's concerns, NUI/City Gas hereby amends its filing and request for approval as follows:

1. The Company modifies Program 3, the Residential Appliance Replacement Program, to provide that incentives are available for ranges and clothes dryers under the program only when an existing service line is present, or at least one other qualified appliance is installed at the same time as the range or clothes dryer.

2. The Company withdraws Program 4, the City Gas Company of Florida Dealer Program.

3. The Company modifies Program 9, the Commercial / Industrial Conversion program to exclude conversions from oil to natural gas from the program. This modification is being made due to staff's concerns that oil to gas conversions may not pass the participant test for certain of the Company's commercial and Industrial rate classes.

4. The Company modifies Program 10, the Commercial / Industrial Alternative Technology Incentive Program to provide that NUI/City Gas will file the cost-effectiveness analysis for any project under this program, with its Energy Conservation Cost recovery filing for the period in which the initial payment is made. This will allow the Staff to evaluate the cost-effectiveness analysis and determine the appropriateness of expenditures associated with the project in its review of conservation expenditures.

WHEREFORE, City Gas Company of Florida respectfully requests that the Florida Public Service Commission approve its filing and authorize the Company to implement the conservation programs filed herein for Energy Conservation Cost Recovery.


