**ENRON CAPITAL & TRADE RESOURCES CORP.'S
MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE AN AMICUS CURIAE
MEMORANDUM OF LAW AND REQUEST TO ADDRESS THE COMMISSION**

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.037(2), F.A.C., Enron Capital and Trade Resources Corp. ("ECT") moves the Commission for leave to file the accompanying Amicus Curiae Memorandum of Law addressing the issues raised by the Petition for Declaratory Statement filed by Duke Mulberry Energy, L.P. and IMC-Agrico Company. Also, ECT requests leave to address the Commission at the Agenda Conference where the Petition for Declaratory Statement is considered.

ECT is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Enron Corp. ("Enron") and conducts virtually all of Enron's world-wide merchant operations. ECT's core businesses include all types of transactions involving natural gas, electricity, crude oil and natural gas liquids. These activities include acquiring and developing energy related assets, as well as providing finance and risk management products to its customers. ECT is the largest independent marketer of natural gas and, through its wholly-owned subsidiary Enron Power Marketing, Inc., is the largest independent marketer of wholesale electricity in the United States.

ECT is currently discussing the development of merchant power plants with prospective Florida customers and has an interest in promoting competition in the wholesale electrical power market.

ECT submitted written comments to the Commission staff in response to a staff

request for comments regarding the applicability of the Florida Electrical Power Plant Siting Act to merchant plants. ECT also participated in the staff workshop held on November 7, 1997, where responses to the staff's request were discussed. Further, ECT participated in the informal meeting held by Commission staff on November 17, 1997, to discuss the procedural issues present in this Docket and in Dockets Nos. 971313 and 971446.

ECT respectfully submits that its participation in the Docket will assist the Commission in considering the issues raised by the Petition, some of which have not been fully addressed by others.

ECT respectfully requests that the Commission allow ECT to file the accompanying Amicus Curiae Memorandum of Law and address the Commission at the Agenda Conference.
