

said in an interview after the vote. "But in my mind, it was not absolutely conclusive that it will be deceptive."

Clark and Deason could not be reached for comment. During discussion before the vote, Clark said the PSC would go after the company if it were found to be misleading consumers.

The commission's vow to be vigilant, however, did not satisfy state watchdogs. "It's obvious on its face that the name is intended to deceive people," Beck said.

KTNT is primarily going after consumers who dial "0" for operator to make long-distance calls from pay phones. Nevertheless, the certificate allows the company to offer long-distance service to homeowners and businesses in Florida.

KTNT first began operating in Texas in 1995 out of the home of the company's president, Dennis Dees, in Kennedale, Texas. The Texas Public Utility Commission said Dees registered 57 names with the agency, including "Any One is Okay" and "Whatever."

The company received approval from Michigan and Ohio in April 1997. That same month, the Florida PSC was set to vote on KTNT's request before Gross asked the panel to delay making a decision so the attorney general's office could investigate the company. At the time, Dees insisted the company is not

trying to mislead anybody.

"We're going after an offbeat target, the people who are fed up with all the other long-distance companies," he said. "The objective is not to fool. It's perhaps to entertain a little bit." Even the name "KTNT" sounds like a more popular long-distance company when said quickly.

But state officials were not amused. In a hearing in May, Gross pointed out that KTNT had withdrawn applications in Georgia, Nevada and Maryland in the face of opposition from regulators in those states.

Despite acknowledging that KTNT's business practices are controversial, the Florida PSC staff recommended approval of KTNT's certificate after it found no solid evidence that customers in Texas or other states had been misled.

The Texas Public Utility Commission has not received many complaints about KTNT, "certainly not at a level you might expect for a company that has such devious names such as 'I Don't Care' or 'It Doesn't Matter,'" said spokeswoman Leslie Kjellstrand. She added that complaints are rare because the company's long-distance rates are middle of the pack.

Still last fall, the Texas commission approved a new method of assigning long-distance operators to prevent companies like KTNT from "gaming" the system.

'I Don't Care' latest choice in long-distance

■ A company is cleared to also operate in Florida as "It Doesn't Matter." The company hopes to snare customers not interested in specifying a carrier.

If you care at all who your long-distance phone company is, you might need to watch your language.

State regulators gave permission Tuesday to a Texas long-distance company to operate under the names "I Don't Care" and "It Doesn't Matter."

With names like that, KTNT Communications Inc. hopes to get business by default when unsuspecting customers express indifference and repeat those words when asked to choose a carrier. The marketing gimmick has brought the company more than \$1-million in sales in at least three other states.

The Florida Public Service Commission came under fire immediately for granting KTNT a certificate to

do business in the state. Some state officials had vociferously opposed the company's proposal, charging that the names are inherently misleading and deceptive.

"I think it reflects poorly on the commission to approve a business plan such as KTNT's," said Michael Gross, an assistant attorney general. "To me, it's just a matter of common sense."

The Office of the Public Counsel, which represents consumers in regulatory issues, was dumbfounded by the decision. "We are shocked," said Charles Beck, assistant public counsel.

A panel of commissioners voted 2-1 to allow KTNT to do business in Florida, agreeing with a PSC staff recommendation. Commissioner Susan Clark and E. Leon Jacobs voted in favor; J. Terry Deason dissented.

Jacobs said he had misgivings about the matter yet approved KTNT's application because the company met the state's financial, technical and managerial requirements for telephone companies. "It was a tough call on my part," he

Obviously, the PSC doesn't care

By giving a long-distance carrier the go-ahead to operate under the inherently deceptive name "I Don't Care," the Florida Public Service Commission has shown, once again, that it doesn't care enough about protecting Florida's consumers.

This week, a PSC panel approved Texas-based KTNT Communications' plan to snag Florida business — and unwary customers — with its new company names "I Don't Care" and "It Doesn't Matter." From now on, whenever an undecided consumer uses those magic words when asked to choose a long-distance carrier, KTNT will automatically get the call. It's bad enough that KTNT would want to snooker the public. But did its cynical ploy have to bear the PSC's seal of approval?

The PSC's rubber-stamp is outrageous, even for an agency with a long history of putting industry benefit before public interest. KTNT's scheme was vigorously opposed by

the attorney general and public counsel as misleading and deceptive on its face. Yet, by a vote of 2-1, the panel decided to cast those objections aside and give KTNT license to play games and exploit consumer confusion.

If names matter so little to the PSC, perhaps they will matter more to Floridians angry at being played for fools. So here are the names of the two commissioners who voted to approve KTNT's request: Susan Clark and E. Leon Jacobs. Commissioner J. Terry Deason voted "no."

So, consumers, watch what you say. KTNT has told the PSC it plans to target mainly pay-phone callers, but its state certificate is broader than that. You can bet it won't be long before unsuspecting homeowners are misled into accepting service they did not request or switching to a company they did not approve.

We'll all have the PSC's Jacobs and Clark to thank for that.

I am responding to your email message to Commissioner Susan F. Clark in which you expressed concern about the Commission's decision to allow KTNT Communications (KTNT) to operate in Florida under the names "I Don't Care" and "It Doesn't Matter."

To give you some background, KTNT filed its application on January 24, 1997. Acting on the belief that KTNT had met the requirements for receiving a certificate, the full Commission initially approved the application using the Proposed Agency Action procedure on August 18, 1997. The Office of Public Counsel (OPC) and the Attorney General (AG) filed a petition on the Commission's proposed action and requested a hearing. The matter was assigned to a three-member panel and a hearing was held on May 28, 1998.

As for the decision by the panel to allow KTNT to operate under the two fictitious names, "I Don't Care," and "It Doesn't Matter," the criteria specified by Florida law for granting certificates are specific and limited. Section 364.337(3), Florida Statutes, provides that the Commission "shall grant a certificate of authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service upon a showing that the applicant has sufficient technical, financial, and managerial capability to provide such service."

The OPC and the AG did not dispute that KTNT met the financial and technical requirement portion of Section 364.337(3). They both, however, argued that KTNT does not have the managerial capability to operate in Florida. The OPC and the AG expressed during the hearing that the use of the name was deceptive. In reaching its decision, the majority of the panel members reasoned that the OPC's and the AG's argument was speculative and that there was no solid evidence in the record to show that customers have been misled or harmed in Texas or other states where KTNT has been using these names to provide operator services. The KTNT witness disagreed with the misleading and deceptive analogy, contending that when a person says "I don't care" in response to being asked which carrier they want to use, the operator should respond by informing the customer that there is a company by that name. If the operator fails to ask the customer if he or she wishes to use that carrier, there is yet another opportunity for the customer to be informed of the carrier's identity. The Commission's rules require interexchange carriers to "brand" all operator-assisted calls. Upon hearing the brand, which is a clear statement of the name of the company, the customer could then choose to abandon the call.

Florida has had competition in the long distance market for some time now, and consumers have become accustomed to choosing carriers. Because of vigorous competition, consumers are exposed to advertising and marketing contacts from the various competitors. Given the significant exposure to long distance company marketing, it is not unreasonable to assume that customers who respond "I don't care" when asked which long distance company they want to use are truly indifferent. Therefore, the selection of KTNT through this process should not result in a confused or dissatisfied customer.

Please be assured that consumer interests are a prime concern of the Commission. We will not hesitate to revisit this decision if KTNT fails to comply with the Commission's rules, orders and policies.

■ A company is cleared to also operate in Florida as "It Doesn't Matter." The company hopes to snare customers not interested in specifying a carrier.

If you care at all who your long-distance phone company is, you might need to watch your language.

State regulators gave permission Tuesday to a Texas long-distance company to operate under the names "I Don't Care" and "It Doesn't Matter."

With names like that, KTNT Communications Inc. hopes to get business by default when unsuspecting customers express indifference and repeat those words when asked to choose a carrier. The marketing gimmick has brought the company more than \$1-million in sales in at least three other states.

The Florida Public Service Commission came under fire immediately for granting KTNT a certificate to

do business in the state. Some state officials had vociferously opposed the company's proposal, charging that the names are inherently misleading and deceptive.

"I think it reflects poorly on the commission to approve a business plan such as KTNT's," said Michael Gross, an assistant attorney general. "To me, it's just a matter of common sense."

The Office of the Public Counsel, which represents consumers in regulatory issues, was dumbfounded by the decision. "We are shocked," said Charles Beck, assistant public counsel.

A panel of commissioners voted 2-1 to allow KTNT to do business in Florida, agreeing with a PSC staff recommendation. Commissioners Susan Clark and E. Leon Jacobs voted in favor; J. Terry Dession dissented.

Jacobs said he had misgivings about the matter yet approved KTNT's application because the company met the state's financial, technical and managerial requirements for telephone companies. "It was a tough call on my part," he




Dear Mr. Morales:
