Greetings!

I come before you this day, as I did when testimony was given to you when hearings were being held when talk of the 954 area code and the split of Broward from Dade and 305 was being considered.

On September 6, as I read the articles about the various splits and overlay plans for area codes I wondered again about the decision to choose a more confusing and frustrating option rather than that which would be simpler for subscribers throughout this region as well as throughout the Nation.

It was not surprising to read about the frustration caused by the imposition of additional areacodes in Cities such as Los Angeles and Chicago and this area is headed for the very same headaches.

In applying the 954 area code to Broward and leaving the 305 areacode to Dade and Monroe Counties the split took place along 'County Line Rd.' and defined 'Broward' as a 'foreign entity' separate from 'Dade'.

The only thing that never changes is 'change' itself. Everything is subject to change. We change from conception through birth, the childhood years, the teenage years, adulthood and (finally) death. We move constantly from one stage to another. Sometimes change is slow and steadfast, sometimes it is unexpected. Change can be rapid, anticipatory, joyful, sad, constructive, destructive or slow, traumatic, unexpected, encouraging or deadly. We would be foolish if we did not expect change to take place. Change can be useful and productive and, we hope, the 'future of change' and the 'change of future' will, with wisdom, be applied in and to that 'change' which we have, inevitably, to face.

In reading about the proposed changes to Dade and the 305 area it is my conviction that, once again, the most confusing and frustrating of choices is being considered.

There is talk that, by the year 2000 the Broward area code 954 will need to be split. That whatever decision is made with the current 305 area code, it too will need to be split again as early as 2005.

There is the possibility of exhausting all areacodes by the year 2025, according to the projections.

To my way of seeing things, should all the demands for phone numbers continue with increased rapidity, before the year 2010 arrives the availability of areacodes will have begun to be exhausted.

At the present moment there are nine area codes existing throughout Florida. With 8 million potential numbers available per area code, that gives a total of 72 million potential numbers. With the addition of one more area code being applied to Dade County, that would increase to only 80 million potential numbers.

I would like to suggest, once more, that instead of adding an additional areacode that the least confusing choice would be go proceed with 8 digit dialling. In other words not only develop the Dade/Monroe 305 area code into 8 digits dialling, but create 8 digits dialling throughout the length and breadth of Florida. Without establishing one additional area code the current nine area codes would immediately ^{have} stepped forward with the potential for 576 million potential telephone numbers.

Chicago now has 5 area codes. Had they gone to 8 digits dialling instead they would already have had the availability of 64 million potential numbers long before any additional area code would have been needed.

It seems that somewhere recently I read that in Los Angeles they have had 9 area codes imposed upon them. According to the same mathematical formula that has created a potential of 72 million numbers. Should this be true, had they chosen (instead) to proceed with 8 digits dialling they would have, with one area code, had 64 million potential numbers available and would only now be considering the possibility of a need for a second area code which would have created 128 million potential numbers. Consider the difference of 8 digits dialling as against the current system of nine areacodes (each with 8 million potential numbers) as outlined above.

Florida does not really need additional area codes now. What is needed is 8 digits dialling. It is a simpler transition without the traumatic frustration that one experiences with an area code switch and the imposition of forced 10 and 11 digits dialling because one is compelled to dial their own area code along with the local 7 digits.

Oct. 1, 1997.

Many years ago, while working as a Cable Operator with Western Union International, I saw a new system of formatting messages and made enquiries. This was a new computerised system and I got very excited over it and began to put the messages I typed into that format. The reason being that 'I saw the future' dawning and chose to prepare for it. The response I got from those who had not grasped the vision that came to me was 'why bother to do this now? Wait until you have to do it.' My response to that was 'this is the way of the future, I want to prepare for the day when it becomes necessary.'

I was called all kinds of names because I saw the future and sought to prepare for it. However, when the time came when everyone was forced to prepare their messages in that format the question to me was 'am I doing this right?'

By choosing not to decide on 8 digits dialling reminds me of those days back in the 60's and the words spoken then, because it was not felt necessary to rethink one's philosophy is 'why bother with 8 digits dialling now? why not wait till we have to do it.'

The future is unfolding at express speed upon us.

With the currently known technologies available, and those yet unknown technologies yet to be developed, should a rethinking of the philosophies not take place then the future will not just come upon us with express speed it is going to arrive with a crushing speed.

Without a vision the people perish.

Please do not lack in wisdom to catch the vision and rethink the need for 8 digits dialling instead of rushing ahead with the addition of new area codes.

The idea of using two area codes in the same general vicinity just doesn't sound right, and it does not make much sense for the standard telephone call to have to use ten digits to call across the street.

Maybe BellSouth can try this: Create the new area code and put all the beepers, cell phones and fax machines in Dade and Monroe Counties in this new area code. It is inconceivable to me that anyone on the commission thinks that an area code overlay is the right solution for the shortage of telephone numbers that will soon arise in South Florida, specifically in Dade & Monroe counties. If a change needs to be made, I would be happy to surrender the (305) code to Monroe County, and even to split Dade up geographically, with 2 area codes in the north and one in the south, for one in Miami Beach and one in Coral Gables and one in the rest of the county.

The idea that I may have to calculate, before I call my next-door neighbors, how long they have lived at their present address in order to know which area code to dial in order to reach them, is mind-blowing.

If, as you propose, new customers will receive a different area code with their new phone number, and customers down the block or across the street will have a different area code, you are inviting chaos. I can't begin to calculate how many wrong numbers will be dialed daily in Dade & Monroe Counties, tying up the phone lines with three as many calls as necessary until the right number is found. If this plan has ever worked in any other metropolitan area, I would be amazed to hear of it. What could be more cumbersome and inconvenient? I can't imagine. Ten-digit dialing is bad enough when the area code makes sense! Please don't do this!





At a regularly scheduled meeting of the Key West City Commission, Tuesday 5 August 1997, I sponsored a resolution protesting the above referenced changes. This resolution was an "Add-on" to our agenda and was passed unanimously. You should be receiving it from our City Clerk, Josephine Parker, under separate cover.

The City of Key West, and Monroe County are almost entirely dependent on tourism. It is our primary economy and unfortunately, anything that affects this, affects us all. There are hundreds of businesses that depend on their reservations for the bulk of their business. Confusing the unfamiliar, potential customer with two DIFFERENT AREA CODES for our small string of islands is unconscionable, while the remaining few who do get here will be further confused in trying to communicate locally. There is a national mind-set that there is one area code to a defined area.

Our county, the "long string of islands" is equally dependent on our tele-communication system for day to day contact, and we often wonder why we must continue to pay long distance rates for a county of 60,000 people. These changes will only further complicate local dialing.

You will notice my frequent use of the word "depend". Again, unfortunately, we here in Monroe County and Key West do "depend" on the telephone. Far more than other areas. Please consider our special problems before you make any final decisions.

As a small business in the Florida Keys, Monroe County, and Area Code 305, we categorically object to this absurd overlay plan.

Please insure that Bell South continues a "traditional" area code assignment by geography, instead of haphazard guessing. Either Monroe County keeps the 305 code and Dade gets a "new, improved, bigger and better Area Code" or Dade does. Do not allow the telephone company to continue business as usual, for their convenience!

We continue to pay exhorbitant telephone bills for a linear telephone physical plant that has been in place for years. I am a computer software developer and I recently read an article in The Miami Herald that described plans to convert Dade and Monroe counties to a 10-digit "overlay" telephone dialing plan. The proposed plan contains one significant "flaw" that will adversely affect many computer users, cellular telephone users, and all businesses that employ automated faxing services.

The problem is that automated faxing and dialing programs, including *Microsoft Fax* (bundled with *Windows95*) and many cellular phones, are designed to dial a "1" plus the area code if the area code does not match that of the caller's.

The proposed BellSouth scheme, as described by The Herald, necessitates dialing a 10-digit number for local calls and an 11-digit number ("1" plus the 10 digits) for long distance calls, even within the same area code. It is quite difficult—and in some cases impossible—to program cellular phones and some faxing software to recognize the difference between a local and long-distance call. Even when the software is flexible enough to handle this inconsistency, the business or end-user would have to load in all of the exchanges that are long distance to their location.

The Herald stated that New York City residents are already dialing 10-digit numbers. This is not exactly the case. If you call a number from New York City that has a different area code than yours (for example, from one borough to another or to a cellular/pager/fax), you dial a "1", then the area code, then the number. The NYNEX switch determines whether the call is local or long distance. Businesses, and users of faxing software and cellular phones can then use the simple, consistent rule of "1 plus area code plus number."

I am petitioning you to review this matter, focusing on consumer simplicity. Florida residents and businesses will prefer a straightforward, consistent method of dialing over the proposed method. A former New Yorker, I know first hand how quickly people got used to dialing "1" then a 10-digit number, because it was consistent. I am now a BellSouth customer and judging from the myriad of advanced features and services they offer, I am sure that they have the technology, the expertise and the talent to program their switch for consistency and ease of use.

Thank you for your time. I would also be happy to appear before any group or commission deciding this issue.

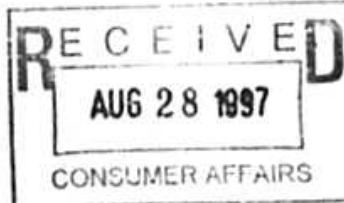

Dear Public Service Commission:

BellSouth's intention to overlay another area code over our existing Monroe & Dade County 305 area code, without regard to geography, must be stopped. Please demand that they either code Monroe, or Dade, with the 305 code and give a new code to the other geographic entity; do not allow them to overlay two codes onto two distinctly separate geographic areas.

If you allow them to overlay area codes you would further subordinate Monroe County to Dade County. As a small business, if we request information assistance from Bell South, we stand to incur double charges for 411 directory information service. Under BellSouth's plan, we would have no area designation as to the location of a company or customer we are trying to find. If we paid for directory assistance in the 305 area code and could not find our party, we would have to take time to search the new, overlaid area code, incurring another charge; double jeopardy!

Please realize, Monroe County alone is 150 miles long, and we rely on the telephone number (area code and exchange prefix) to give us some indication of where a customer, or supplier, is located. To change such a nationwide, indeed, worldwide, geographic based telephone numbering system, is ludicrous.
