RE: DOCKET NO. 971567-TI - Determination of appropriate method for refunding overcharges on intrastate long distance service provided by WorldCom Technologies, Inc. for calls placed from pay telephones.

Issue 1: Should the Commission accept WorldCom Operator Services, Inc.'s refund calculation of \$47,500.00, adding staff's interest calculations of \$3,373.61, for a total of \$50,873.61, and proposal to credit customer bills between February 1 and April 30, 1998, for overbilling end users on intrastate calling card calls placed between August 1996 and June 1997?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should accept WorldCom's refund calculation of \$47,500.00, adding staff's interest calculations of \$3,373.61, for a total of \$50,873.61, and proposal to credit customer bills between February 1 and April 30, 1998. Any remaining monies, including interest due unidentified consumers, should be remitted to the Commission within 30 days following the refund period and deposited in the General Revenue Fund, pursuant to Chapter 364.285(1), Florida Statutes.
