

12 two words were taken out of Issue 3. Survey.

13 **COMMISSIONER CLARK:** Shouldn't the issue
14 really be whether or not they should be surveyed?

15 **MS. KEATING:** Actually Issue 3 is whether
16 they should pay an additive.

17 **COMMISSIONER CLARK:** Okay. Where is the
18 issue as to whether it should be surveyed?

19 **MS. WHITE:** No. 1.

20 **COMMISSIONER CLARK:** Okay. I see.

21 Are there any changes to be made to the
22 draft Prehearing Order, and we'll start with you,
23 Mr. Erwin?

24 **MR. ERWIN:** No, I don't have any.

25 **COMMISSIONER CLARK:** Ms. White?

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MS. WHITE: None, except for the addition of Mr. Hanna to the appearance list.

COMMISSIONER CLARK: Mr. Bishop.

MR. BISHOP: No, ma'am.

COMMISSIONER CLARK: Are there any other matters we need to take up?
