STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Indiantown Gas Company of Florida (IGC or "the Company"), by and through its undersigned officer, offers the following as its Statement of Issues and Positions for consideration at the forthcoming hearing on Purchased Gas Adjustment:

Issue No. 1: What is the Company's total net true-up amount for the period April 1996 through March 1997?

IGC Position: An underrecovery of \$3,202.

Issue No. 2: What is the Company's estimated net true-up amount to be collected during April 1997 through March 1998?

IGC Position: An underrecovery of \$46,102.

Issue No. 3: What are the estimated therm sales for the projected period April 1997 through March 1998?

IGC Position: 5,008,700 therms.

Issue No. 4: What should the maximum levelized purchased gas cost factor be for IGC for the period April 1998 through March 1999?

IGC Position: \$0.38026 per therm.
