PETITION OF PEOPLES GAS SYSTEM FOR APPROVAL OF ITS CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY FACTORS

Peoples Gas System ("PGS"), by its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to Rule 25-17.015, Florida Administrative Code, hereby petitions the Commission for approval of its conservation cost recovery factors to be applied to bills rendered for meter readings taken between April 1, 1998 and March 31, 1999 inclusive, and to continue in effect thereafter until modified by the Commission. Petitioner alleges:

1. The name of the petitioner and the mailing address of its principal office is:

3. The conservation cost recovery factors were calculated in accordance with the methodology which has been previously approved by the Commission in this docket. The factors are designed to recover the projected conservation program expenses of PGS for the period October 1, 1998 through March 31, 1999, adjusted for the net true-up (which includes the

estimated conservation true-up for the period October 1997 - September 1998), as well as interest calculated in accordance with the methodology established by the Commission. The calculation of the factors and the supporting documentation are contained in the prepared testimony of PGS witness Vernor I. Krutsinger, which prepared testimony is filed herewith.

4. PGS projects total conservation program expenses, net of ail program revenues, of \$3,379,788 for the period October 1, 1998 through March 31, 1999. The net true-up is an underrecovery of \$2,543,430. After increasing the projected conservation expenses by the amount of this underrecovery, \$5,923,218 remains to be recovered during the April 1998 - March 1999 period. When this expense is allocated to the affected rate classes pursuant to the methodology approved by the Commission, and expanded for taxes, the recovery factors for the period April 1998 - March 1999 required to recover such expense are 4.794 cents per therm for the Residential rate class, 0.600 cents per therm for the commercial street lighting rate class, 4.433 cents per therm for the small commercial rate class, 1.748 cents per therm for the commercial rate class, 1.417 cents per therm for the Commercial - Large Volume 1 rate class, 1.031 cents per therm for the Commercial - Large Volume 2 rate class, and 0.461 cents per therm for the Natural Gas Vehicle Service rate class.

WHEREFORE, Peoples Gas System prays the Commission will grant this petition, and approve the conservation adjustment factors hereinabove set forth to be applied to bills rendered for meter readings taken between April 1, 1998 and March 31, 1999, inclusive.
