PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF FLORIDA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY'S CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY FACTORS

- 3. In accordance with the procedures established in this docket, FPU has prepared and filed direct testimony¹ and composite exhibit MAP-1² in support of its proposed conservation cost recovery factors. This evidence demonstrates that the levelized conservation cost recovery factors for the period April 1998 through March 1999 should be \$.00038 per KWH for the Marianna per KWH for the Marianna division and \$.00024 per KWH for the Fernandina Beach division.
- 4. As demonstrated in the direct testimony and exhibit MAP-1, the recoverable conservation costs for the period April 1998 through March 1999 are projected to be \$96,000 for Marianna and \$92,400 for Fernandina Beach. The estimated conservation cost recovery true-up amounts for the period October 1997 through September 1998 are projected to be an underrecovery of \$9,652 for Marianna and an over-recovery for \$8,575 for Fernandina Beach. These amounts are based upon actual data for October and November, and estimated data for December through September.
- 5. The resulting net total projected conservation costs to be recovered for the period

 April 1998 through March 1999 are \$105,652 for Marianna and \$83,825 for Fernandina Beach.

 Based upon the projected sales for each respective division, the appropriate levelized

 conservation cost recovery factors for the period April 1998 through March 1999 are \$.00038 per

 KWH for the Marianna division and \$.00024 per KWH for the Fernandina Beach division.

²Composite exhibit MAP-1, which consists of Schedules C-1, C-2, C-3, C-4 and C-5 for Marianna (pages 1-22), and Fernandina Beach (pages 23-44), is being filed with this Petition and is incorporated herein.

FPU's approved conservation cost recovery factors should be effective for all
meter readings on or after April 1, 1998, beginning with the first or applicable billing cycle for
the period April 1998.

WHEREFORE, Florida Public Utilities Company requests the Commission to approve its above-stated conservation cost recovery factors for the Marianna and Fernandina Beach divisions to be applied to customer bills for the period April 1998 through March 1999 and to billings thereafter until such time as another cost recovery factor is approved by the Commission.
