paid \$25,000 for it as we are located in
the Forest and our entrance was from S.R. 40
with a beautiful entrance from 46 through the
old Rainbow Springs attraction. I could walk
to the clubhouse and pool. We were promised
a paved road to the clubhouse through the
park which was supposed to belong to the residents
forever.

When Chase Enterprises sold to the state, now Rainbow
Springs State Park, they didn't grandfather in our
road so now we have to drive $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the
clubhouse with the dangerous intersection.

They took away our road - Please
Don't let them take away our water -
