They so not even have a standby generator and when electricity goes off the people using this utility have no water. We have a generator of our own and are able to have water and sewerage during an outage. We are better served by our own system than are friends being served by Rainbow Springs Utilities.

Since your commission did not include our area in their service area 16 years ago we see no reason for you to do so now that we have all installed wells, septic tanks and many have generators.
