**SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT OF MCI TELECOMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION**

On January 20, 1997, MCI filed its Report in the above-named matter. In that report, MCI informed the Florida Public Service Commission that it had refunded \$1,493,672.30 to affected customers. MCI also informed the Commission that, after initially refusing, it appeared that GTE would accept and process credits for its local customers in mid-January 1998. MCI stated that it would supplement its report to reflect the additional amounts refunded.

GTE has now processed the credits in question and an additional \$24,257.13 has been refunded. The total amount refunded is now \$1,517,929.43. As a result, MCI has refunded 88.91 percent of the total amount of funds identified for refund plus interest. The total amount of principal plus interest in this matter is \$1,707,411.92. As a result of these additional refunds, \$189,482.49 now remains unrefundable.

The GTE credit file was transmitted January 16, 1998, and confirmed January 20, 1998. The following are the confirmation statistics:


