In accordance with Fla. Stat Ch 364 183 (1995), Fla Admin Code Ann R 25-22 006, and Fla. R. Civ. P. 1.280(c), GTE Florida Incorporated (GTEFL) files its notice of intent to request confidential treatment for certain information provided by GTEFL in response to the Office of Public Counsel's (OPC) First Set of Requests for Production of Documents, served on January 16, 1998.
