


SPECIAL SERVICE AGREEMENT AREA

PER CHAPTER 376.307, FLORIDA STATUTES (F.S.), THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, WATER SUPPLY RESTORATION PROGRAM (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE WATER SUPPLY PROGRAM") IS AUTHORIZED TO EXPEND FUNDS FROM THE WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE TRUST FUNDS TO REPAIR OR REPLACE CONTAMINATED POTABLE WATER SYSTEMS. THIS STATUTE PROVIDES FOR SUBSIDIES TO CONNECT THESE POTABLE WATER SUPPLIES TO EXISTING PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY SYSTEMS OR EXTENSIONS THEREOF, PROVIDED THAT NO SUCH SUBSIDY SHALL EXCEED THE PRESENT WORTH OF THE 10 YEAR COST OF PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING FILTERS FOR THE RESIDENTS SERVED BY THE CONNECTIONS. THE 10 YEAR PRESENT WORTH COST OF PROVIDING FILTERS TO THE HOMES WITH CONTAMINATED WELLS ON THE PROPOSED S.E. 12TH PLACE ROAD AND S.E. 11TH AVENUE WATER LINE EXTENSION IS GREATER THAN THE ESTIMATED \$31,885.32 PROJECT COST.


UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF CHAPTER 376.307, F.S., THE WATER SUPPLY PROGRAM AGREES TO CONTRIBUTE \$31,885.32 TOWARD THE CORRECTION OF THE MODEL HOMES LISTED IN ATTACHMENT A TO THE SUBSIDIARY UTILITIES WATER SYSTEM. THE \$31,885.32 PROJECT COST INCLUDES THE COST TO EXTEND AND ENLARGE THE MAIN AND THE UTILITY CONNECTION FEES. THESE FUNDS SHALL INCLUDE ALL FEES ASSOCIATED WITH EACH CONNECTION AS FOLLOWS:

\$342.06	HOOK UP FEE (MODEL HOME)
\$ 15.00	SERVICE CHARGE
2117.00	10% BACKFLOW PREVENTER
\$474.06	TOTAL FEES PER CONNECTION

A MAXIMUM OF 7 CONNECTIONS TO SUBSIDIARY UTILITIES WATER SYSTEM SHALL BE MADE UNDER THIS AGREEMENT UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT IN WRITING. THE TOTAL FEES TO BE PAID BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR THESE CONNECTIONS SHALL NOT EXCEED \$3,324.02. THE REMAINING AMOUNT SHALL BE APPLIED TO THE ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE MAIN EXTENSION, ESTIMATED TO BE APPROXIMATELY \$28,561.30.


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UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF CHAPTER 376.307, F.S., THE WATER SUPPLY PROGRAM AGREES TO CONTRIBUTE \$31,885.32 TOWARD THE CONNECTION OF THE MOBILE HOMES LISTED IN ATTACHMENT A TO THE SUNSHINE UTILITIES WATER SYSTEM. THE \$31,885.32 PROJECT COST INCLUDES THE COST TO EXTEND AND ENLARGE THE MAINS AND THE UTILITY CONNECTION FEES. THESE FUNDS SHALL INCLUDE ALL FEES ASSOCIATED WITH EACH CONNECTION AS FOLLOWS:

\$342.86	HOOK UP FEE (MOBILE HOME)
\$ 15.00	SERVICE CHARGE
<u>\$117.00</u>	RPZ BACKFLOW PREVENTERS
\$474.86	TOTAL FEES PER CONNECTION

A MAXIMUM OF 7 CONNECTIONS TO SUNSHINE UTILITIES WATER SYSTEM SHALL BE MADE UNDER THIS AGREEMENT UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT IN WRITING. THE TOTAL FEES TO BE PAID BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR THESE CONNECTIONS SHALL NOT EXCEED \$3,324.02. THE REMAINING AMOUNT SHALL BE APPLIED TO THE ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE MAIN EXTENSION, ESTIMATED TO BE APPROXIMATELY \$28,561.30.
