shall:


- (a) Rule on all pending motions;

- (c) Schedule, limit, order, or expedite discovery;
- (d) Pursue the possibilities of settlement;
- (e) Require each party to identify all known witnesses that may be called and indicate the subject matter of their testimony;
- (f) Require each party to identify all known exhibits, and specify their contents, identifying separately each component of any composite exhibit;
- (g) Require each party to state its basic position in the proceeding;
- (h) Require each party to state each question of fact the party considers at issue;
- (i) Require each party to state each question of law the party considers at issue;
- (j) Require each party to state the issues to which they have stipulated; and
- (k) Take any other action to further the progress of the litigation.
