
Dear Sir,

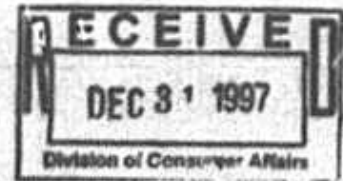
We have no desire, requirement or reason for a public water or sewer system. We don't want it, we won't hook up to it, and we certainly won't pay for it.
