Dear Mr. Friedman:

As you are aware, at the February 17, 1998, Agenda Conference, the Public Service Commission (PSC) voted to approve a reuse availability fee for Alafaya Utilities, Inc. (Alafaya) that would be applicable in the new territory where there are no existing customers. In addition, the PSC voted to require Alafaya to put the developers on notice of the reuse availability fee through the developer agreements and to advise future customers of the fee through the utility's application for wastewater service.

In accordance with the Commission's decision, the staff requests that the utility provide the following for our review: (a) the proposed language regarding the reuse availability fee which will be included in the utility's developer agreements and in the utility's application for wastewater service, and (b) the proposed application for reuse service.
