Dear Mr. Short:

We are pleased to learn of your proposal to provide public drinking water to the residents and lot owners of Sebring Lakes subdivision in units 1A, 1B, 2A, 2B, and 2C. Extensive groundwater contamination has been documented by the Health Department in this subdivision. Consequently, it is delineated under Chapter 62-524, FAC and requires costly deep aquifer construction standards for each private well.

Construction of a public water system will be a public health benefit by providing safe drinking water to the families of the existing and future homes. Ethylene dibromide (EDB) is found in the surficial aquifer of this subdivision at values above the maximum contaminate level and is a known carcinogen. The health risks associated with long term exposure to other found pesticides and nitrates continues to be evaluated.

The Health Department supports your proposal as it advances our public health goal of safe drinking water for all citizens and visitors of Highlands County. It is through these kinds of improvements in basic infrastructure that the foundation for healthy communities is established. Please let me know if we can assist you in this endeavor.


