OnePoint Communications-Georgia, LLC d/b/a OnePoint Communications ("OnePoint-Georgia") is currently the holder of Alternative Local Exchange Company ("ALEC") Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 5250 and Interexchange Company ("IXC") Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 5251. OnePoint-Georgia's ALEC Certificate was granted by the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") in Order No. PSC-97-1299-FOF-TX issued in Docket No. 971024-TX on October 20, 1997. OnePoint-Georgia's IXC Certificate was granted by the Commission in Order No. PSC-97-1260-FOF-TI issued in Docket No. 971025-TI on October 14, 1997.

The purpose of this letter is to advise the Commission of an anticipated change in the corporate structure of OnePoint Communications, LLC, which is the parent company of OnePoint-Georgia. In the near future, OnePoint Communications, LLC will covert from a Delaware limited liability company into a Delaware corporation through a merger with and into OnePoint Communications Corporation, which was formed in Delaware on March 26, 1998. The shareholders of OnePoint Communications Corporation will be the same as the members of OnePoint Communications, LLC.
