TECHNICAL TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS

- "BFC" "BFC" is the abbreviation for "Base Facility Charge" which is the minimum charge to the Company's customers and is separate from the amount billed for water consumption on the utility's bills to its customers.
- "CERTIFICATE" A document issued by the Commission authorizing the 2.0 Company to provide service in a specific territory.
- "COMMISSION" "Commission" refers to the Florida Public Service 3.0 Commission.
- "COMMUNITIES SERVED" The term "Communities Served", as mentioned in 4.0 this tariff, shall be construed as the group of consumers or customers who receive water service from the Company and who's service location is within a specific area or locality that is uniquely separate from another.
- 5.0 "COMPANY" - East Marion Water Distribution, Inc.
- "CONSUMER" Any person, firm, association, corporation, governmental 6.0 agency or similar organization supplied with water service by the Company.
- "CUSTOMER" Any person, firm or corporation who has entered into an 7.0 agreement to receive water service from the Company and who is liable for the payment of that water service.
- "CUSTOMER'S INSTALLATION" All pipes, shut-offs, valves, fixtures and 8.0 appliances or apparatus of every kind and nature which are located on the customer's side of the "Point of Delivery" and used in connection with or forming a part of the installation necessary for rendering water service to the customer's premises regardless of whether such installation is owned by the customer or used by the consumer under lease or other agreement.
- "MAIN" A pipe, conduit, or facility used for conveying water service 9.0 through individual services or through other mains.

- "RATE SCHEDULE" The rate(s) or charge(s) for a particular 11.0 classification of service plus the several provisions necessary for billing, including all special terms and conditions under which service shall be furnished at such rate or charge.
- "SERVICE" Service, as mentioned in this tariff and in agreement with 12.0 customers, shall be construed to include, in addition to all water service required by the customer the readiness and ability on the part of the Company to furnish water service to the customer. Service shall conform to the standards set forth in Section 367.111 of the Florida Statutes.
- "SERVICE LINES" The pipe between the Company's mains and the point of 13.0 delivery and shall include all of the pipe, fittings and valves necessary to make the connection to the customer's premises excluding the meter.
- "TERRITORY" The geographical area described by metes and bounds with 14.0 township, range and section in a certificate, which may be within or without the boundaries of an incorporated municipality and, may include areas in more than one county.

INITIAL CONNECTION - This charge would be levied for service initiation at a location where service did not exist previously.

NORMAL RECONNECTION - This charge would be levied for transfer of service to a new customer account at a previously served location or reconnection of service subsequent to a customer requested disconnection.

VIOLATION RECONNECTION - This charge would be levied prior to reconnection of an existing customer after disconnection of service for cause according to Rule 25-30.320(2), Florida Administrative Code, including a delinquency in bill payment.

PREMISES VISIT CHARGE (IN LIEU OF DISCONNECTION) - This charge would be levied when a service representative visits a premises for the purpose of discontinuing service for nonpayment of a due and collectible bill and does not discontinue service because the customer pays the service representative or otherwise makes satisfactory arrrangements to pay the bill.


