3. My letter dated April 17, 1998, clarifying that a sale or transfer of the utility, prior to receiving Commission approval, would be an apparent violation of Section 367.071, Florida Statutes. Included with my letter is the application package needed to process a sale or transfer of a utility. Again, if you choose to go forward with the certification process, it is imperative that you also file the application for transfer as soon possible.
