We have received your e-mail correspondence dated April 20, 1998 requesting information regarding the proposed rate increases of United Water Florida, Inc. (UWF). As stated in your letter. you wish to obtain information about the Florida Public Service Commission's procedures in rate proceedings and what rights customers have in those proceedings. I have attached a pamphlet that describes the procedures that the Commission utilizes for water and wastewater rate increases.

Currently, UWF has two rate increase dockets open. The first one is Docket No. 971596-WS,

which is a Petition for limited proceeding regarding other post-retirement employee benefits (OPEB) and petition for variance from or waiver of Rule 25-14.012, Florida Administrative Code. This is a requested increase to recover the OPEB costs for 1994 through early 1997 that were not approved in UWF's last rate case. Staff's recommendation on this limited proceeding is currently due to be filed on June 4, 1998. The Commissioners are scheduled to vote on this docket at the June 15, 1998 Agenda Conference. The second docket is Docket No. 980214-WS, which is an application for increased water and wastewater rates in Duval. St. Johns and Nassau Counties. The rate case does
