Recommendation: If the utility timely responds to the show cause order, staff believes that this docket should remain open pending disposition of the response. If the utility fails to timely respond to the show cause order, the penalty should be deemed assessed with no further action required by the Commission, and this docket should remain open pending remittance of the penalty. If the utility timely responds in writing to the show cause order and requests a hearing, this docket should remain open for final disposition. Further, staff recommends that this docket should remain open pending receipt of the utility's application for a grandfather certificate and final disposition of the application.
