Dear Mr. Ade:

We have reviewed the utility's application including the minimum filing requirements submitted on May 18, 1998, on behalf of the above-mentioned utility. After reviewing this information, we find the minimum filing requirements to be deficient. The specifics are identified below:

1. Schedule C-7, Page 3 of 3. This schedule requires a copy of the election made under Section 46(f), Internal Revenue Code. The schedule indicates that it will be supplied at a later date. The schedule must be supplied with the minimum filing requirements.
2. Schedule G-46, Pages 1-5 of 6. The Allocation Factor" column is illegible. A legible copy must be filed.
3. Rule 25-30.437(3), F.A.C., This rule requires the inclusion of a schedule which describes in detail all methods and bases of projection, explaining the justification for each method or basis employed. The minimum filing requirements as filed contain no justification for the plant additions projected for the calendar years ended 1998 and 1999.
