Dear Rosanne:

I am writing this letter as a follow-up to our telephone conversation yesterday in which I inquired about the status of the Application for Transfer of Majority Organizational Control of Radnor Utilities in the above-referenced docket. Having recently learned of a revision to the Commission staff's CASR schedule which revised the due date for the staff recommendation and agenda to July 23, 1998 and August 4, 1998 respectively, I wanted to reiterate my concern and desire that this matter be handled as quickly as possible.

As you are well aware, this matter is uncontested and uncontroversial. The last input provided by the Utility (or requested by the staff) occurred in October of last year. We are now fast-approaching a deadline set by the purchaser and seller of the Utility system as an unwind date if action has not been finalized. The dates proposed in the staff's most recent CASR get us dangerously close to that unwind date.

While I understand that the staff members assigned may have substantial workloads, in dealing with other projects that may have statutorily imposed time limitations, I believe in light of the


