

MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME

Comes now Amer-I-Net Services Corp. ("Amer-I-Net") and files this Motion for Additional Time. As basis, Amer-I-Net would state:

1. By Order No. PSC-98-0549-SC-TI issued April 20, 1998 this Commission issued a show cause order to Amer-I-Net for alleged violations of Rule 25-4.118, Florida Administrative Code. On May 7, 1998 the Commission granted an extension of time to respond to the show cause order.
2. On June 11, representatives of Amer-I-Net met with Staff for purpose of proposing a resolution of the Order. As a result of this meeting, Amer-I-Net has prepared an offer to file with the Commission and expects to file the offer either with this Motion or within 5 work days from this Motion. The additional time is needed in order to resolve an issue raised by Staff after the meeting.
3. The brief additional time requested by Amer-I-Net will not delay final disposition of this matter and may contribute to an expedited disposition if protracted litigation can be avoided. Further, the additional time will not adversely affect consumers or provide benefits to Amer-I-Net. Although Staff counsel assigned to this docket has been unavailable to discuss this motion, the undersigned does not believe that she would object to the brief extension requested herein.


