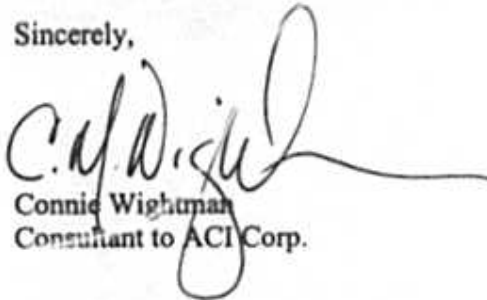

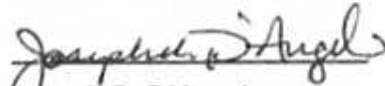

ACI is well positioned to succeed in the rapidly changing telecommunications market, and has the financial resources necessary to operate as a local exchange and interexchange provider of both high-speed data and voice services in the state. ACI plans an aggressive service roll out to meet residential and business consumer demand for innovative telecommunications services, particularly high-speed data services, and voice services as demanded by customers. The proposed initiation of services in the state requires a significant investment by Applicant, and it is intended that the investment required will be contributed by Applicant's corporate parent and funded out of such parent's current capitalization and operations. The primary source of funding for such parent is investments by private and institutional investors. While not reflected in the 1997 audited financial statements, ACI's parent company recently received \$150 million in funding through a public debt offering. ACI is a privately held company and its financial information is proprietary in nature. Because the financial statements relating to ACI are confidential and contain proprietary information, they will be submitted under separate cover to the Commission, and are not to be made a part of the public record. Such financial statements will demonstrate that ACI will have access to all funds needed to provide its proposed services in the state. Such financial statements are in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.

As demonstrated herein, ACI Corp. d/b/a Accelerated Connections, Inc. has the financial resources and financial management skills to provide Alternative Local Exchange Service in Florida.
