Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPU"), by and through its undersigned counsel, submits its preliminary list of issues and positions in connection with the hearing that is scheduled for August 26-28, 1998 in the above-styled docket.

ISSUES AND POSITIONS**GENERIC FUEL ADJUSTMENT ISSUES**

Issue 1: What are the appropriate final fuel adjustment true-up amounts for the period October, 1997 through March, 1998?

FPU's Position:

Marianna: \$125,045 (over-recovery)
 Fernandina Beach: \$121,303 (over-recovery)

Issue 2: What are the estimated fuel adjustment true-up amounts for the period April, 1998 through September, 1998?

FPU's Position:

Marianna: \$47,885 (over-recovery)
 Fernandina Beach: \$125,825 (over-recovery)

Issue 3: What are the total fuel adjustment true-up amounts to be collected or refunded during the period October, 1998 through December, 1998?

FPU's Position:

Marianna: \$172,930 to be refunded
 Fernandina Beach: \$247,128 to be refunded

Issue 4: What is the appropriate recovery period to collect/refund the total fuel adjustment true-up amounts?

EPU's Position: FPU does not object to a refund period of three months (October-December, 1998) or a longer period if the Commission determines that it is appropriate to maintain the current fuel cost recovery factors in effect subject to a true-up in the establishment of the 1999 factors.

Issue 5: Should the Commission allow the electric utilities to keep their levelized fuel cost recovery factors at the rate set by Order No. PSC-98-0412-FOF-EI, in Docket No. 980001-EI, issued March 20, 1998, for the period October, 1998, through December, 1998?

EPU's Position: FPU does not object to such a proposal.

Issue 6: What are the appropriate levelized fuel cost recovery factors, excluding demand cost recovery, for the period October, 1998 through December, 1998?

EPU's Position:

Marianna: 2.112¢/kwh
Fernandina Beach: 2.006¢/kwh

Issue 7: What should be the effective date of the new fuel adjustment charge, oil backout charge and capacity cost recovery charge for billing purposes?

EPU's Position: FPU's approved fuel adjustment and purchased power cost recovery factors should be effective for all meter readings on or after October 1, 1998, beginning with the first or applicable billing cycle for the period October, 1998.

Issue 8: What are the appropriate fuel recovery line loss multipliers to be used in calculating the fuel cost recovery factors charged to each rate class?

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
