ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING NAME CHANGE

By letter dated August 25, 1995, Quest Communications Corporation Interexchange Telecommunications Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Number 2483, requested that Certificate Number 2483 be amended to reflect the fact that the operating name is "QCC, Inc., d/b/a Quest Communications Corporation of Kansas." Upon review of the Department of State, Division of Corporations' records, it appears that Quest Communications Corporation has properly registered QCC, Inc., d/b/a Quest Communications Corporation of Kansas. Accordingly, we find it appropriate to amend Certificate Number 2483 to reflect the new operating name.
