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I checked back through the file, and there are several legal documents that have the name "Orchid Springs Development Corporation" while the application has the name "Orchid Springs Development Corp. Water & Sewer." The name on the application is of course what we go by when setting up the docket in CMS and MCD, and we rely on staff (or the company) to advise us if a correction is needed. Ideally, we get that advice BEFORE the final order goes out. In this case, the name in the docket

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title portion of the order reflects the name as shown on the application, while the name used throughout the order is the name from the legal documents--in other words, there is a discrepancy in the order. Is an a-order needed? To correct our records, I will ask Nonnye by copy of this e-mail to correct MCD, and I will correct CMS, based on the name shown on the legal documents in the file.
