Issue 2: Should the Commission grant All American's Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to Order to Show Cause and Motion for Further Extension of Time to Respond to Order to Show Cause?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should grant both motions in order to provide All American an opportunity to pursue settlement negotiations with staff.

**APPROVED**

Issue 3: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: No. If staff's recommendation in Issue 1 is approved, this docket should remain open pending final resolution of the show cause proceeding. If All American does not timely file a protest of the Commission's proposed agency action order, the fine in the amount of \$370,000 should be deemed assessed. If the fine is not received within five business days after expiration of the protest period, this docket should be closed.
