NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Florida Public Service Commission that FLORIDA PAY PHONE SYSTEMS, INC.'s petition for waiver of Rule 25-24.515(8), Florida Administrative Code, filed April 21, 1998, in Docket No. 980544-TC was approved on June 16, 1998. The rule requires that pay telephones must allow incoming calls to be received unless they are located at a confinement facility, hospital, school, or another location specifically exempted by the Commission. Requests for an exemption must be accompanied by an attestation by the owner of the pay telephone, the location provider, and the chief of the responsible law enforcement agency that the request is made to deter criminal activity at that pay telephone. The petition was approved on the basis that the petitioner met the requirements for an exemption. Notice of the petition was published in the FAW on May 15, 1998.
