Issue 2: Should the Commission require InVision Telecom, Inc. to modify its tariff to block incoming calls from confinement facilities?

Recommendation: No. If the Commission approves staff's recommendation in Issue 1, InVision will operate under the Talton tariff. The Talton tariff does not include the incoming call blocking language that originally concerned staff and was the source of numerous complaints. Therefore, there is no need to modify the InVision tariff.
