Issue 2: Should RHV Utility, Inc. be ordered to show cause why it should not be fined up to \$5,000 per day for its failure to comply with Order No. PSC-97-0854-FOF-SU which required the utility to refund customer deposits and submit refund reports regarding the customer deposits?

Recommendation: No. The utility should not be ordered to show cause why it should not be fined up to \$5,000 per day for its failure to comply with Order No. PSC-97-0854-FOF-SU by not providing refunds of customer deposits held in excess of Rule 25-30.360(7), Florida Administrative Code.

Issue 3: Should RHV Utility, Inc. be ordered to show cause why it should not be fined up to \$5,000 per day for its failure to comply with Order No. PSC-97-0854-FOF-SU which required the utility to escrow the increased revenues associated with pro forma additions approved in that order?

Recommendation: No. The utility should not be ordered to show cause why it should not be fined up to \$5,000 per day for its failure to comply with Order No. PSC-97-0854-FOF-SU by not placing in escrow all the increased revenues associated with pro forma additions approved in that same order.

Issue 4: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: If the Commission approves staff's recommendation in Issues 1, 2, and 3, no further action is required. Accordingly, Certificate No. 429-S should be canceled, and this docket should be closed.
