



**COMCAST MH TELEPHONY COMMUNICATIONS OF FLORIDA, INC.'S  
REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL  
CLASSIFICATION OF RESPONSE TO DATA REQUEST NO. 2(c)**

Comcast MH Telephony Communications of Florida, Inc. ("CMHTCFL"), pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006(4), Florida Administrative Code, hereby submits this request for confidential classification of portions of its responses to the ALEC Data Requests (1998 Competition Report) filed with the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") Staff on July 30, 1998 in the above matter. In support of this Request, CMHTCFL states as follows:

1. On July 10, 1998, the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission requested that CMHTCFL, a certificated ALEC, provide responses to several data requests related to the 1998 Competition Report (the "Data Requests"). CMHTCFL believes that certain information and material in its responses, specifically its response to Data Request No. 3(c) (more precisely, lines one and two thereof) and to Data Request No. 3(d) (more precisely, lines one and two thereof) is confidential and proprietary information.
2. Data Response No. 3(c) identifies the number of business access lines currently served by CMHTCFL in the State of Florida. This information directly relates to CMHTCFL's competitive interests, and its disclosure would impair CMHTCFL's competitive business interests by allowing competitors to determine CMHTCFL's market success (or lack thereof) State of Florida. This information is intended to be and is treated by CMHTCFL as proprietary and confidential. Accordingly, CMHTCFL requests that this information be classified as "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of Section 364.183(3)(e), Florida Statutes. However, CMHTCFL would not object to this information being aggregated with the similar information of other service providers and made publicly available, so long as the CMHTCFL-specific information is not separately identified.
3. Data Response No. 3(d) identifies the number of residential access lines currently served by CMHTCFL in the State of Florida. This information directly relates to CMHTCFL's competitive interests, and its disclosure would impair CMHTCFL's competitive business interests by allowing competitors to determine CMHTCFL's market success (or lack thereof) State of Florida. This information is intended to be and is treated by CMHTCFL as proprietary and confidential. Accordingly, CMHTCFL requests that this information

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be classified as "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of Section 364.183(3)(e), Florida Statutes. However, CMHTCFL would not object to this information being aggregated with the similar information of other service providers and made publicly available, so long as the CMHTCFL-specific information is not separately identified.

4. One copy of an unedited version of CMHTCFL's responses to the Data Requests is being submitted herewith in a sealed envelope with the information asserted to be confidential highlighted. Two copies of the edited version of the document on which the information asserted to be confidential has been blocked out with an opaque marker and is enclosed herewith.
5. CMHTCFL requests that the information for which it seeks confidential classification remain confidential for a period of at least 18 months as provided in Section 364.183(4), Florida Statutes.

**WHEREFORE**, for the foregoing reasons, CMHTCFL respectfully requests that its Request for confidential classification be granted.
