AREA CODES;

These is a very simple and logical solution to the problem of Area Codes.

Area Codes should follow ZIP Codes.

That is, we should have 328 for our Area Code.

UPS already use the first 3 digits of the ZIP Code for their locating.

We already use 4 digits to enter a long distance number (i.e. **1 407** 123 4567) .

Eventually we may use 5 digits because of the proliferation of telephonic devices.

At that time, a straight 5 digit Area Code would follow, so that our own Area Code would become (in this case) 32806.

That would probably tie in with other systems like E-Mail, etc., etc.
