Enclosed are an original and fifteen copies of Gulf Power Company's Revised Tariff Sheets No. 6.41, 7.42, 6.1 and 7.1 regarding GoodCents Surge Protection, (formerly Enhanced Power Quality.)

In order to be more consistent with marketing strategy, Gulf seeks to change the name of the Enhanced Power Quality tariff (EPQ) to GoodCents Surge Protection (GCSP).

Gulf continually seeks ways to improve customer satisfaction and to simplify contracts with our customers whenever possible. Surge Protection through Gulf's tariff has been available since May 1992. Currently, there are approximately 7,000 customers participating in this offering. It has proved to be a beneficial service for both Gulf and our customers.

Our review of the program indicates most customers are satisfied with the surge protection service offered through the tariff and tend to stay on the rate long term. Long term can easily be defined as a period in excess of a year and in most cases, well beyond. The number of customers requesting discontinuance of the service within the first year is minimal and is usually the result of a relocation or move. Therefore, Gulf proposes to eliminate the upfront commitment of a 12-month service contract. Service would be provided on a month-to-month basis. The agreement could be terminated by either party with notice.
