Ladies and Gentlemen:

In response to the Florida State Legislature's House Bill No. 4785 (Chapter 98-277) I am enclosing a copy of my last telephone bill for my condominium on North Hutchinson Island, with the following comments:

1.- The entire bill is an incoherent jumble-mumble of charges

My phone was not used once between July 10 and August 10, but I was charged \$25.66 , 25.35% of which consists of taxes .

It goes without saying that the different charges and fees are never explained and nobody knows whether they are legitimate or not.

There is nother problem unrelated, however, to the rate structure and that is the mailing of bills, not only by Bell South, but also Florida Popwer and Light. Both utulities assess late charges, if bills are not paid by a certain date, but neither one of them mail their bills on the date they are dated and the envelopes bear no posting dates. Some bills are mailed up to seven days after the billing date. This is in clear violation of postal regulations. The postmark on the envelope is the governing date and in the absence of such postmark and only a Statement on the enevelope "Presorted First Class Mail U.S. Postage Paid Bell South" It a company uses a Pitney-Bowes Mailing Machine and shows the incorrect mailing date all envelopes will be run through the cancellation machine by the Post Office and repeated violations of this regulation will result in the revocation of the Permit by the Post Office. This matter should be handled by the Public Service Commission and both utilities should be required to show mailing dates on their envelopes or get rid of their late charges.
