- Issue 4:** How should Gulf Power Company calculate the separation factor used to allocate transmission revenues associated with economy, Schedule C, broker transactions between the retail and wholesale jurisdictions?
- Issue 5:** How should Tampa Electric Company calculate the separation factor used to allocate transmission revenues associated with economy, Schedule C, broker transactions between the retail and wholesale jurisdictions?
