RE: Docket No. 980307-WS - Application for certificate to provide water and wastewater service in Orange County by Zellwood Station Co-Op, Inc.

Zellwood Co-op Station (Zellwood or utility) filed an application for original certificate with the Commission on March 4, 1998.

On March 23, 1998, the Commission received a letter of protest from the Banbury Village Association, Inc., (Association). The Association also requested a hearing. The matter was set for hearing on March 8-9, 1999.

On September 4, 1998, the utility and the Association filed a proposed settlement offer in which the Association agreed to neither protest the original certificate nor the utility's rates for a period of three years. The utility agreed to not seek a rate case for the same period. The utility also agreed not to charge the customers the conservation rate until after all meters were installed. Staff will present a recommendation to the Commission at the earliest possible agenda conference.

Therefore, please ask the Chairman to perform the following:

- 1) Cancel the Prehearing Conference scheduled for February 3, 1999, and
- 2) Cancel the Hearing scheduled for March 8-9, 1999.
